Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS)

Canon complies with the EU RoHS Directive (2011/65/EU) and RoHS-like laws implemented in countries other than the EU. The RoHS Directive aims to minimise the human health impact and environmental impact of waste electrical and electronic equipment at the end of its life by reducing the legal quantities of certain substances that the equipment may contain. Products sold in Europe, Middle East and Africa may not currently contain more than specified concentrations of lead, cadmium, mercury, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) and polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) in accordance with requirements under the RoHS Directive excepting for exemption specified in Annex III and IV of the RoHS Directive.
